

## AFCEA Scholarships

The Cochise College Subchapter of the Southern Arizona AFCEA Chapter provides opportunities for students to be awarded a variety of scholarships throughout each year. Although the actual award amounts depend on the number of applications and our funding for that particular year, we typically award scholarships in the \$50 - \$100 range. We offer two types of scholarships – book scholarships and general scholarships. ***Book scholarships are only open to paid members of the Cochise College Subchapter, while General Scholarships are open to any student enrolled at Cochise College and active in AFCEA club activities.***

**Scholarships are not for a particular set amount – some of the criteria include (but are not limited) to the following:**

- *Course load*
- *Participation in Chapter and Subchapter activities to include Chapter General Membership meetings, club meetings, CyberPatriot outreach, Computer Challenge and other club events.*
- *Financial need*

### **Scholarships for the Spring Semester**

The spring scholarships consist of only the book scholarships. Applications can be found on the Cochise College Subchapter web site ([http://afceacochise.org/afcea\\_club](http://afceacochise.org/afcea_club))

- Scholarships forms must be submitted by the announced due date (found on the subchapter web site) to the Club Faculty Advisor. You will get a confirmation from the advisor that he/she has received your application.
- Notification of scholarship awards will be made as soon as possible after the due date to allow students to plan their spring semester finances.

### **Scholarships for the Fall Semester**

The fall scholarships consist of both general and book scholarships. Applications can be found on the Cochise College Subchapter web site ([http://afceacochise.org/afcea\\_club](http://afceacochise.org/afcea_club))

- Scholarships forms must be submitted by the announced due date (found on the subchapter web site) to the Club Faculty Advisor. You will get a confirmation from the advisor that he/she has received your application.
- Notification of scholarship awards will be made as soon as possible after the due date to allow students to plan their fall semester finances.
